CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

The Parish Council have received half the monies for local expenditure for the new financial year. The increased budget will allow for some 'traffic calming' measures to be introduced during the year, which is the most commonly raised issue from people attending the Parish Council meetings.

A large number of people complained that they could not walk along the pavements, and were forced into the road, led the Council to placing notes on windscreens of cars, where the pavement was blocked. This has proved to be an unpopular measure and has been put 'on hold'.

On 10th June 2008 a meeting will be held in the Village Hall to discuss all matters relating to traffic calming. Please come along and join in the debate. The Council want to hear as many views as possible before making any decisions.

Thank you to all those who attended the Annual Assembly, which again was a great success - details of which are included in the Ticehurst News and Views.

POLICE REPORT

During April there were 59 calls made to the Police of which there are six recorded crimes.

- 1. Lead stolen from roof of building in London Road, Flimwell - house to house enquiries were carried out without result, and enquiries are on going.**
- 2. Diesel was stolen from parked lorries in a yard in Ticehurst Road - this matter is still Under investigation although suspects were caught attempting to steal diesel in Brightling in the early hours of 4th May.**
- 3. A car had the lock forced at a car park at Three Legged Cross and a handbag was stolen

- 4. One reported burglary when 14 tortoises were stolen from a farm on the Ticehurst Road.**
- 5. One report of criminal damage - where a car was keyed in Springfields.**
- 6. Extensive enquiries have been made regarding the graffiti around Ticehurst - Four names have been suggested and enquiries are still on-going.**
