## **Neighbourhood Priorities Update.**

### **Speeding and Anti-Social behaviour; What you said: The panel agreed speeding remains an issue in the ward, Frant Road was highlighted regards speeding traffic.**

What we did: Panel advised of publicity with regard to Road traffic Policing speed enforcement operation in roads previously identified by the panel. The results of the recent Roads Traffic Policing Operation at the panel meeting have been advised. ### **Drugs; You said; you were concerned about Drug misuse and supply.**

What we did: Directed patrol, intelligence based community engagement and partnership working conducted and reported back to panel members accordingly. We have been paying attention to areas where we have reports that drugs use and supply is a concern. To date it appears this problem is under control. What happened : Directed patrol, intelligence based community engagement and partnership working has been conducted and reported back to panel members.

### **Police Presence; What you said; To continue to see police presence within the town creating public reassurance Dealing with any antisocial behaviour**

What we did;We have had regular street meetings with PCSO Neve are being held on a monthly basis. Police are out on foot patrol, interacting with the community and liaising with local parish council/nhw members Local NFU meeting held, and PC Simmonds and PCSO Neve attended promoting farmwatch, and giving general crime prevention advice in relation to poaching/heating oil thefts and encouraging reporting of any suspicious activities to police
